

Passive Income

What is passive income?

- Passive Income (also known as residual income) is money that comes to you even when you're not actively working.
- Active Income is money that stops coming to you when you stop working, such as a day job.
- To earn passive income, you'll need upfront investment – money, time, etc.



Passive Income examples

- Rental Income
- Interest from a bank account
- Dividend or Interest from stocks & Bonds
- Royalties from published book or patent
- Earnings from Internet Advertisement on Websites
